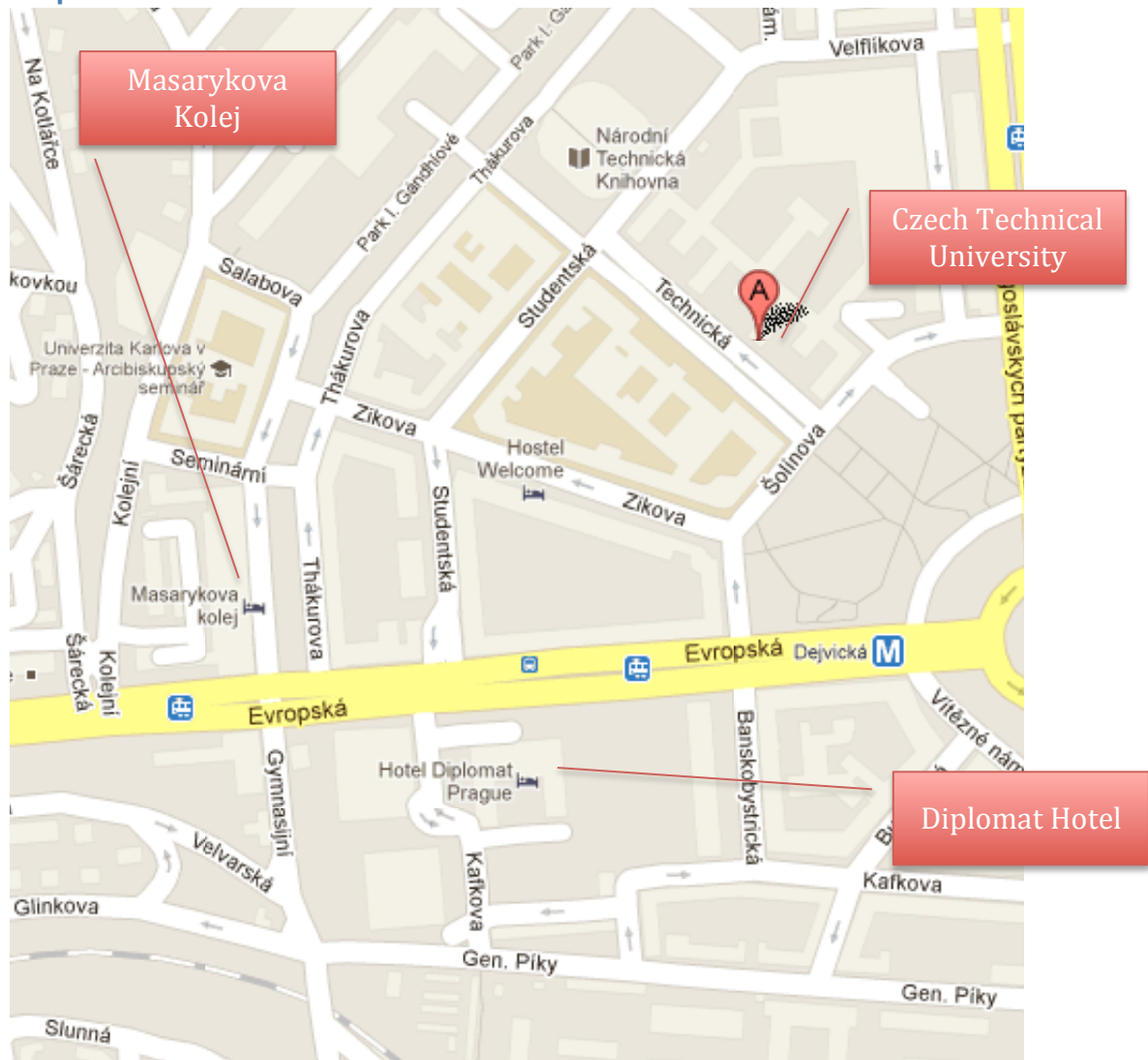

Dress code/behavior guidelines

The following simple rules are to be followed to ensure successful representation of your school while you are at the event:

- The first impression counts: dress smart; possibly wear a shirt with the name of your school or team uniform if you have one
- Be considerate for the others: avoid any strong aftershave/perfume but use of deodorant will be helpful to survive the whole day.
- Be punctual: Time is precious. The schedule is tight and we need your cooperation to stay within the time allotted for each activity. Your punctuality represents respect for the one(s) you are racing with.

Please wear your badge at all times to ensure that you are recognized as a race participant



Press

Members of the press will be attending the event. In case of interview or video/photo taking requests, remember that all what is seen and said might appear in newspapers, magazines and on the Internet. Answer questions clearly and act natural.

Around the racetrack

The following procedures are to be observed while around the track:

- Walking around the racetrack is allowed only with socks. No shoes allowed. Make sure you have clean socks. Shoes should be stored in orderly fashion by the stage or at your technical table
- Only 1 car at the time can run on the track
- It is recommended for other team members to be around the track to catch the car in case it goes out of the circuit
- Spectators are not allowed on the track. Only Freescale personnel and supporting staff can help on it.

Timing and racing process

The racing sequence will be communicated at check-in time. This will tell you when your team will have to be ready to be on the track. The car can be picked up from the inspection table only while the previous team is running their car.

Each team will be given 2 opportunities to race on the track for each qualification round:

- When called, team is to come on the track, position the car behind the start line
- When the timing system is ready, you will be notified and you are to start your car within 1 min.
- Car runs 1 lap on the track
- Time is taken and recorded.
- If the car runs out of the track. Team members are to retrieve the car and prepare it for the 2nd attempt. You have max 2 min to get the car ready.
- Between the 2 attempts, battery change is allowed. No laptop or wireless connection is authorized for car reprogramming.
- 2nd attempt is to start within 2 min from the crossing of the finish line at the 1st attempt
- Car runs 1 lap on the track
- 2nd attempt's time taken and recorded
- Best lap time is kept as qualifying time

Usage of the Garage area

Each team will have the opportunity to use the Garage area to prepare the car for the race. The Garage is equipped with electrical outlets for computer and car



battery charging. A few tools are also available for your convenience to help make the last minute repairs/changes.

As there might not be space for all students in the Garage area, we ask for your assistance in clearing the place as soon as you are done with working on your vehicle.

Vehicle inspection and race holding position

All vehicles will have a designated spot on the inspection tables.

At 13:00 on April 3rd, ALL vehicles have to be ready for racing.

From that time, only battery changes can be done on the vehicles for the rest of the race time. Cars must stay on the inspection table until called for racing. Once the car has raced its qualification round, the car is to be returned on the inspection table.

Cars will remain on the inspection table during the evening of April 3rd. No car can exit the racetrack area without prior approval from the Freescale Race Team. If a car is removed without approval from the inspection table, it will be disqualified from the finals.

Lunches

Lunches will be served at the restaurant of the Masarykova Kolej per the schedule communicated above.
